## International and Collaborative Learning with a Focus on Gender, Diversity, and Inclusion between Civil Society Organisations in Latin America

In this session, the author shares a project designed to enhance collaborative internationalisation among Latin American civil society organisations, emphasising gender, diversity, and inclusion. Thirty-two representatives from 15 civil society organisations across Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, Mexico, Paraguay, and Peru have participated in the initiative. Six high-performance teams were established with the aim of co-designing a social project focusing on gender, diversity, and inclusion. Key outcomes achieved through the project included the establishment and maintenance of international strategic alliances among the fifteen civil society organisations. Additionally, the professionalisation of work teams was enhanced, equipping them with the skills required to apply for international funding opportunities. The project contributed significantly to the 2030 Agenda, specifically addressing SDG 17 "Partnerships for the Goals" and SDG 5 "Gender Equality."
